

WORK VISA REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1) Visa application form duly filled by the applicant. Complete residential and official (if applicable) address, telephone numbers, name of parents must be written in the form. In case of minor(s), the form should be signed by both parents. The visa application form can be downloaded from the website www.ambislamabad.esteri.it or <https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home.aspx>
- 2) Two color passport-size photographs no older than 6 months, in white background and un-edited. One photograph must be glued on the visa application and the second one, bearing on the reverse side the applicant's full name, should be attached to the application form with a paper clip.
- 3) Copy of your national ID Card (CNIC)
- 4) An ordinary passport valid at least three months from the expiry date of the visa applied for. This document must have at least two empty pages. Previous passports should also be attached.
- 5) If you have been refused a visa by an Embassy or high Commission in the last two years, written explanation about reason for trip and refusal
- 6) NULLA OSTA (NOC) from the Italian Authority
- 7) Request form for NOC made by the employer to the Italian "Sportello Unico per l'Immigrazione", for the approval of job for the applicant
- 8) Business Profile of the Inviting Italian Company issued by the relevant Chamber of Commerce and Industry
- 9) Personal details of the focal/contact person in Italy (copy of passport, telephone number, ID card...)
- 10) Copy of the last Academic Degree/Certificate of the applicant
- 11) NADRA Family Registration Certificate (FRC) mentioning parents and siblings, and in case of being married, FRC with wife and children should also be attached.

NOTE: A work visa for Italy does not entitle its holder to work in another Schengen State.

- Admissibility of applications will be treated as per Visa Code (EU Regulation (CE) n.810/2009).
- It is highly recommended for timely processing of the application that the same be complete of all the above requested documents.
- The Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional supporting documents
- Any forged/fake documents will be reported to the relevant Authorities
